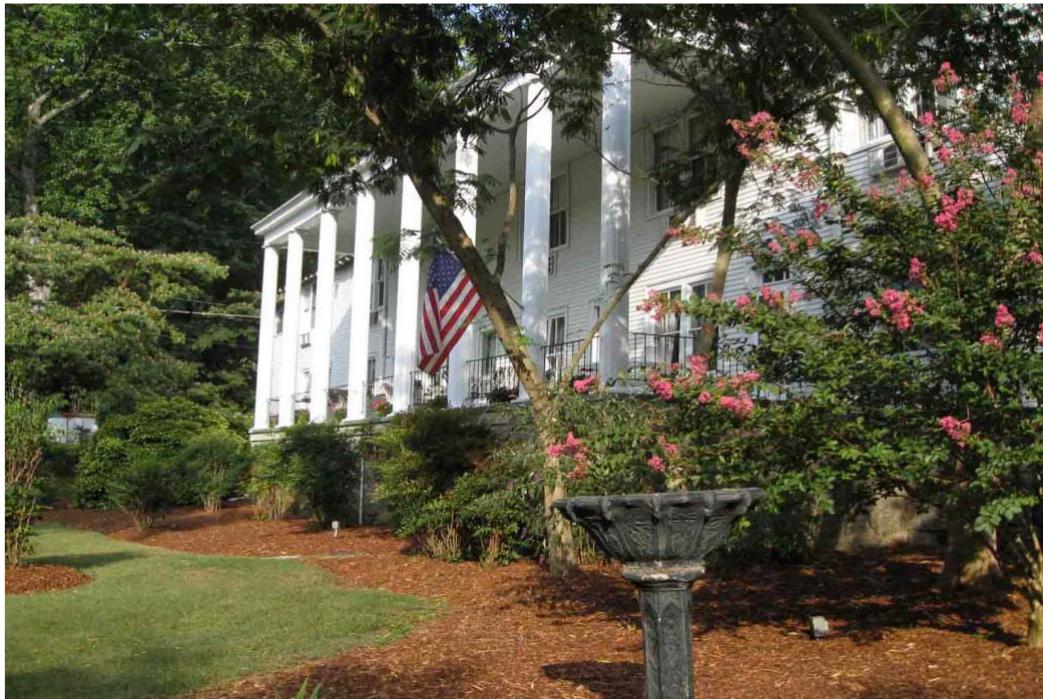


# THE MIMOSA INN

The Tavern at Mimosa offers a lite fare menu in addition to a weekly special 'prix fixe' dinner selection on Friday and Saturday evenings. The Mimosa is an historic 10,000 square foot, 107 year old "Plantation" style mansion with 10 guest rooms, all with private baths and a/c situated on four park-like acres facing the Blue Ridge Mountains. The site is famous for its many champion trees, including the largest Mimosa Silk tree (Albizia julibrissin) growing in the USA. The Inn is also home to many Harlequin Glory Bower (Clerodendrum trichotomum) flowering shrubs that blossom from June to October providing a wonderful light fragrance throughout the summer and fall seasons. The wide-open spaciousness of the Inn's public rooms, porches, patios & 55' front veranda make it an ideal setting for weddings, special occasions or romantic get-a-ways.
